COACHES MEETING

PRACTICE ROUND

One 18-hole practice round must be scheduled with the Chateau Elan staff. Please call 678-425-6050 to reserve your practice round.

In an effort to maintain the conditions of the course and speed of play, each player may play only one ball during any practice round, except each player may chip or putt more than one ball on or near the green only. Each participant must play from the designated tees.

Teams are limited to five players during practice rounds. Groups of six are not allowed, and coaches are not allowed to play during any practice round.

Coaches will be provided time schedules and be responsible for monitoring pace of play. Practice-round pairing and tee times will be determined by reserving your tee time with the Chateau Elan staff at 678-425-6050.

Tiebreaking Procedures

Team ties shall be broken by a sudden-death playoff counting the low four scores relative to par on each hole. Play shall continue with new scoring on each successive hole until a winner is determined. The games committee will determine the starting holes. If a playoff involves more than two teams, a shotgun format shall be used. The team playoff will be conducted first, with the playoff for individual spots to follow immediately after the conclusion of the team playoff. Once the shotgun sudden-death format is started, that format shall be used until a winner is determined.

SCORING

Scorecards for the NBCAHOF Invitational shall be kept in strict accordance with Rule 6-6 of the USGA's 'Scoring the Stroke Play'. The scorecard shall be deemed returned to the golf committee when it is placed by the player or coach in the box located in the designated scoring area. (USGA Scoring Rules below)

6-6. Scoring in Stroke Play

a. Recording Scores

After each hole the <u>marker</u> should check the score with the <u>competitor</u> and record it. On completion of the round the <u>marker</u> must sign the score card and hand it to the <u>competitor</u>. If more than one <u>marker</u> records the scores, each must sign for the part for which he is responsible.

b. Signing and Returning Score Card

After completion of the round, the <u>competitor</u> should check his score for each hole and settle any doubtful points with the <u>Committee</u>. He must ensure that the <u>marker</u> or <u>markers</u> have signed the score card, sign the score card himself and return it to the **Committee** as soon as possible.

Penalty for Breach of Rule <u>6-6b</u>:

Disqualification.

c. Alteration of Score Card

No alteration may be made on a score card after the **competitor** has returned it to the **Committee**.

d. Wrong Score for Hole

The <u>competitor</u> is responsible for the correctness of the score recorded for each hole on his score card. If he returns a score for any hole lower than actually taken, he is disqualified. If he returns a score for any hole higher than actually taken, the score as returned stands.

Exception: If a <u>competitor</u> returns a score for any hole lower than actually taken due to failure to include one or more <u>penalty strokes</u> that, before returning his score card, he did not know he had incurred, he is not disqualified. In such circumstances, the <u>competitor</u> incurs the penalty prescribed by the applicable <u>Rule</u> and an additional penalty of two strokes for each hole at which the <u>competitor</u> has committed a breach of Rule <u>6-6d</u>. This Exception does not apply when the applicable penalty is disqualification from the competition.

Note 1: The <u>Committee</u> is responsible for the addition of scores and application of the handicap recorded on the score card - see Rule <u>33-5</u>.

33-5. Score Card

In stroke play, the <u>Committee</u> must provide each <u>competitor</u> with a score card containing the date and the <u>competitor's</u> name or, in <u>foursome</u> or <u>four-ball</u> stroke play, the <u>competitors'</u> names.

In stroke play, the **Committee** is responsible for the addition of scores and application of the handicap recorded on the score card.
